B. Topic(s)

B-1 Receive Council Direction to Maintain or Abandon Downtown Street Barricades and Designated Parking Stalls Due to Potential Influence of the Delta Variant, an Original Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic (CD)

Community Development Director John Della Monica provided a presentation regarding Downtown street barricades and designated parking stalls. Specific topics of discussion included background regarding the initial installation of the street barricades to provide outdoor seating at Downtown restaurants, information regarding the extension of the barricade program to August 30 unless businesses wanted to pay for the barricades extending the program to October 31, the monthly cost of the barricade rental, the cost of removal and replacement of the barricades, and a request from staff for Council direction moving forward.

Mayor Pro Tempore Chandler made a motion, second by Council Member Hothi, to remove the barricades on August 30 and make accommodations for those businesses that want them, to retain the barricades at the business' expense through September 30, 2021.
