### 2012 Lodi Solar Rebate Program

\*Term: February 2, 2012 to December 31, 2012

\*Rebate/incentive program budget for 2012: \$360,000

\*Rebates only provided for solar systems installed after February 2, 2012, and provided after system is installed and confirmed operational by the City of Lodi and Lodi Electric Utility (LEU)

\*To apply for a rebate, customer must complete application, and submit along with a signed sales contract and documentation showing that an energy audit has been performed on their property (residential customers only)

\*Completed applications and materials noted above will be accepted from November 1, 2011 until January 30, 2012; mailed to:

Lodi Electric Utility; Attn.: Customer Programs; 1331 S. Ham Lane, Lodi, CA, 95242

\*On February 2, 2012, LEU will conduct a public lottery (time and location to be determined) to award rebates from the completed solar rebate applications received from November 1, 2011-January 30, 2012

\*The solar rebate for 2012 is \$2.09/watt, and is determined utilizing the EPBB calculator, accessible at:

- [www.csi-epbb.com](http://www.csi-epbb.com)

- once there, click on 'CSI Standard PV – Current Calculator'; once there, make sure to use PG&E as the utility

\*The maximum rebate is \$7,000/residential system; \$40,000/non-residential system

\*Solar panels must be installed per LEU engineering specifications, and must comply with any state requirements

\*Program funds unused in any one year will be carried forward to the next year or future years

\*Customers will relinquish all environmental and capacity attributes, including, but not limited to. "renewable energy credits" and "Greenhouse Gas credits" to LEU

\*Customers will be paid for electric energy provided to LEU from the installed solar systems pursuant to the Net/Co- Energy Metering rate schedules

\*All customers must complete and sign an electrical interconnection agreement before rebate is issued

\*LEU reserves the right to amend the solar rebate program from time-to-time, as appropriate
